



You are invited to come and form a chapter of *Project Orange* ... a peer learning set ... a small network committed to meet regularly to help motivate and inspire one another; to explore and develop your own ministry/learning project; and to learn from each other.

Is your ministry with children and families a strong, vibrant **ORANGE** ministry?

RED ... the colour of the parents' faith nurturing and discipling of their children ...

&

YELLOW the colour of the church's invitational and discipling ministry with children.

Let's work to strengthen both and explore the synergies.

It is envisaged that each participant would probably have a particular small or large project of their own to develop or implement in their personal, church and/or organisational sphere.

Participants could be the sort of people who would value some input, prayer, encouragement, inspiration, accountability and/or time from their peers.

If you don't have a particular project initially, take the opportunity to come, listen and be open to the possibility of joining in with some else's project as appropriate.

Your project's focus could be:

- Ministry; Evangelism, Theology of Children; Child Theology; Faith with Families; Worshipping with Children

Typical projects could include working to:

- run the monthly integrated worship time WITH families in your church;
- learn time management or another management skill;
- implement an ORANGE schools ministry in your area;
- gather or write a resource for families;
- write a theological essay or even to write a book;
- think through a strategy for ministry;
- produce a newsletter or web site;
- stimulate and resource parents to take responsibility for their own child's faith journey;
- ministry and mission WITH children ... exploring the faith journey WITH children.

Process

Once we discover individual interests, we could explore synergies and possible shared outcomes. We could also have some time at each gathering for worshipful acts! We would meet regularly, at least monthly but frequency would be reviewed by the group once established.
