As part of a School Garden Club experience student's knowledge, resilience, behavior and self-esteem commonly improve. School Garden Clubs and gardening activities have been linked to a wide range of positive student outcomes, including improved literacy and numeracy, scientific knowledge, student confidence, resilience and self-esteem.

SU chaplains and volunteer community mentors currently run Garden Clubs in both urban and rural schools in Victoria. SU builds partnerships with local churches and community volunteers for each Garden Club to support the local school and community.

Childsafe training, volunteer checks and registration, insurance, access to ongoing coaching and SU's experience are all part of the SU partnership.
