(sfx incoming message)

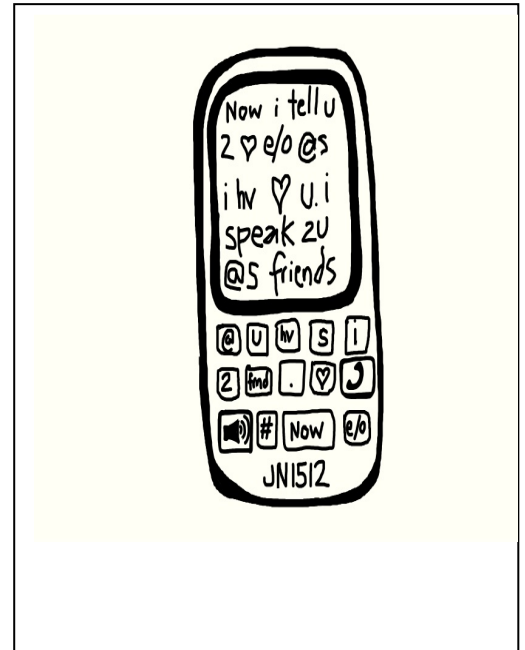
Oh, there it is. Let's look at it together on the JN15-12...
(read slowly pointing to the words/symbols as you go... stop and ask for help from the audience to generate participation)

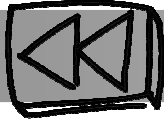
"Now I tell you to love each other, as I have loved you.

(Call up some volunteers and take suggestions, invite audience member to 'key' in the message)

Ok, and send! Great, thanks friends. *(exits)*

Repeat this process again with two other characters – inserting the name of the previous character as the sender.

The final character finishes with...
