
## **Busted!**




John 21:1-17, 18:12-27






Peter is a follower, a follower of Jesus. He's been following and listening and watching and learning. **As Peter** follows Jesus, he discovers God's good ways to live.

Peter followed Jesus, hiding in the shadows, pretending not to know Jesus, afraid that he'd get busted too.







Jesus was killed and put in a grave.
